ADMISSION PROCESS

50% of the seats are filled strictly on merit basis in accordance with the centralized admission process of the university.

APPLICATION

All candidates seeking admission to degree programmes should compulsorily register through CAP (Centralized Admission Process). The registration procedures will be made by the college office. Candidates without CAP registration are not eligible for admission.

MANAGEMENT QUOTA

For admission in the management quota candidates will have to submit application in the prescribed form recommended and signed by any one of the Directors of the management committee. The application form can be had from the college office on payment of Rs.150/-. Students selected under merit quota also have to submit college application form at the time of admission.

INTERVIEW

At the time of interview students should bring their CAP Admit card. In case of Management Quota, the candidates will have to bring CAP Id Number. Students have to report before the Principal with his / her parent / guardian for the interview with the following documents
