• INDUSTRIAL VISIT

B.Sc. Chemistry final year students visited Ernad latex Pvt Ltd, Chemmaram Naduvath, Kerala, on

27/02/2021 on Saturday at 10.00am.Ms.Arunima K.Y (Assistant Professors, department of Chemistry) accompanied the group. This industry was registered in 2008 (mainly focusing on the production of latex) from natural and is senex (60% centrifuged. rubber latex. Ms.Sushama introduced about the functioning of this unit. Natural rubber latex is received in barrels from different farmer and is subjected to chemical analysis for quality measurements. As measurements, DRC, VFA, NH analysis part of quality and Mg content are tested. After that centrifugation is done and 60% centrifuged latex is produced. The processing unit is followed by a water treatment section, where both chemical and biological treatments are done to make waste water free from pollutants. It was one day visit.

• THIRD YEAR BSc. CHEMISTRY PROJECT

BSc, chemistry final year students done their project work as review of various papers. Students were grouped in to three and done project in different problems. They are assisted by Ms.Arunima KV, Ms.Shabnam and Ms.Rinu Jacob.One of the groups reviewed the study of physical and chemical parameters of water samples and another group evaluated on application of Poly Methyl Methacrylate. Other group reviewed on effect of seasonal variations on rubber latex.
